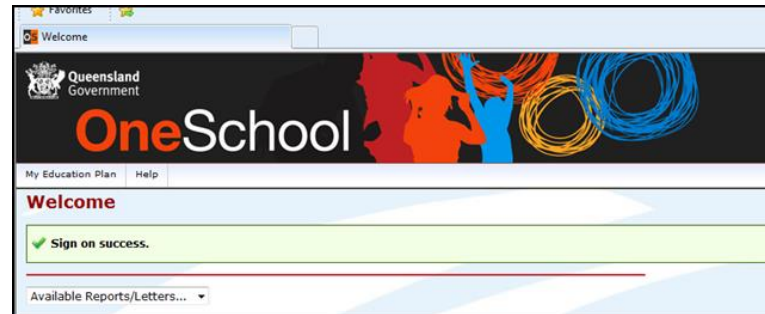

Completing your Subject Selection on-line

1. Complete the paper copy of your form. **This must be signed and returned to the office for your selections to be considered.**
2. Go to <https://oslp.eq.edu.au> and log on using your user name and password that you normally use to access the computers at school.
3. You should now see your school profile. Click on the “career” tab and then choose “subject selection”
4. You should see the message “You currently have no subject selection model selected. Click here to select a new model.” Click on the blue word “here”.
5. This will bring up some options. Choose “Year 10 for 2018” and then save.
6. Click on the “edit” button.
7. Once you have chosen 4 subjects in total, click save.
8. You can then log off.

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Preparing for new senior assessment and tertiary entrance systems

Some key changes:

- A move away from the Overall Position (OP) to an Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR).
- The ATAR is a finer grained rank order of students than the OP and is commonly used in other states and territories. It's a number between 0.00 and 99.95 with increments of 0.05, whereas the OP consists of 25 bands. The Queensland Tertiary Admissions Centre will be responsible for calculating students' ATARs.



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- The first students to receive an ATAR instead of an OP will graduate from Year 12 in 2020.
- There will be fewer assessments than students currently complete — emphasising quality over quantity.
- As in the current system, students should choose subjects according to their learning goals, and what they enjoy and are good at.
- At the start of 2018 there will be a Year 10 information night.
