**Under this agreement for 2016
Ferry Grove State High School will receive**

\$481,256*

This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students in years 7 to 10 achieving a 'C' standard or above in English, Maths and Science.
- Increase the percentage of students across the upper two bands in the NAPLAN tests in years 7 and 9 to 30%.
- 100% of students show a relative gain at least equivalent to their year on year progression from year 7 to 9 in NAPLAN.
- Increase the percentage of year 12 students attaining a Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE) from 98% in 2015 to 100% in 2016.

Our initiatives include

- Provide additional support to demonstrate improved achievement in Mathematics, English & Science.
- Develop teacher capacity to embed reading and numeracy strategies as part of the learning process in every classroom.
- Provide an Academic Excellence pathway for students at Ferry Grove SHS.
- Implement a Literacy and Numeracy Program across Years 7 – 9 to better prepare students for success.
- Improve the monitoring and tracking of students through the implementation of an Academic Success Audit Program in Years 11 & 12.
- Increase opportunities for students to obtain a Certificate III level qualification through engagement with outside providers.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Employ additional teachers and teacher aides as part of an Academic Support Team to provide focused teaching for identified students, literacy and numeracy support via differentiated teaching strategies. 	\$180,000
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Develop and implement a whole school approach to teaching reading and provide professional development and TRS to equip teachers to implement Assessment Literacies through a whole school approach. 	\$120,000
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Further develop, resource and embed the "Learning Excellence at Ferry" program and provide staff with TRS. 	\$20,000
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide access for staff and students to access specialist programs and training aligned to the implementation of Reading and the Tactical Teaching of Reading, Numeracy and Pedagogy. 	\$161,256
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Employ a teacher aide to work with Year 11 and 12 students, the teachers and their parents to help them make decisions that enable them to achieve their highest possible level of attainment as part of the ASAP. 	\$50,000
